What follows describes our offerings for 2024-2025. We have five different approaches for renewing certification(s).

- 1. Successfully completing exam(s) administered at NDSU Extension County Offices.
- 2. Our traditional **face-to-face** trainings.
- 3. Live trainings through web conferencing **hosted** at selected NDSU County Extension facilities.
- 4. Live trainings through **webinars** directly into homes, shops, or offices. The advantage is applicators do not have to travel, but they will need to have a reliable internet connection and a personal computer.
- 5. Finally, in our minor categories (Home Industrial and Institutional, Public Health, Vertebrate, and Wood Preservation), we will continue to have home-study correspondence trainings available from January 1 through April 1, 2025.

We are confident we will be able to meet your certification needs throughout this training season. What follows are the details.

Finally, while I helped craft this training campaign, I will not be conducting it. I plan to retire at the end of the day on November 1, 2024. It has been a privilege to lead this program since 1998. I want to wish you all the best and thank you for your kindness and professionalism.

Face to Face and Hosted Trainings

If you desire to participate in a training, in a meeting room, it is important you consider the following:

- If crowds make you uncomfortable, consider NOT participating in face-to-face trainings.
- Hosted trainings will have fewer numbers because they will be in smaller venues.

Communication

Given the unpredictable nature of the weather, please maintain up to date contact information with our office, especially an e-mail address. Without it, we will not be able to connect with you on short notice. Also, we can only e-mail changes to applicators/dealers that have registered for an event. If you were planning a walk in registration, we will not be contacting you.

Another way you can stay in touch is by monitoring our website. We will post any changes at least 24 hours before the event. Look for: Weather Announcements. Our home page can be found at: https://ndsupesticide.org

Participating in a Webinar

If you select this means of training to complete your renewal, you need to be prepared to handle the technology. Here are some key points:

- We use ZOOM as our webinar delivery platform. We have been using it for several years with minimal problems. Thousands of applicators and dealers across the state have been successful in obtaining a certificate through this approach.
- You do not need a ZOOM account or special software.
- You will need a networked computer with audio and video capabilities. A microphone or camera is not required. You must have sufficient bandwidth to handle video streaming.

- A personal computer/tablet/iPad running Windows or IOS system is necessary. While ZOOM can be run from a networked device, smart phones are problematic due to bandwidth limitations and the inability to see presentations on a small screen. DO NOT USE SMART PHONES.
- If you request participation in a webinar, we will send you additional instructions on "how to participate." This will be in a PDF document and in a narrated step by step video.
- You will need to register with ZOOM for the event so you can obtain login information. We will provide you an e-mail registration link once you have pre-registered with the NDSU Extension Pesticide Program. When you get the link, simply follow the instructions to obtain login information.
- Registering with ZOOM allows us to track your participation before, during, and after the webinar. We use this tracking to verify attendance and participation.
- While participating, refrain from distractions and focus on the content of the training. Doing so will assure the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the North Dakota Department of Agriculture, and the general public that you are committed to using pesticides in a responsible manner.

Completing Exams at County Extension Offices

Renewal by examination will be offered. For 50 years NDSU County Extension Offices have provided local opportunities to take certification exams. While county offices are part of the NDSU Extension system, their operations are governed by county government. Thus, each office may have different requirements and procedures for issuing exams. Applicators/dealers seeking to take exams should order study materials. Once they have them, they should call ahead for an appointment and visit with county staff regarding local policies.

Training Registration

Pre-registration is strongly recommended for all trainings. If we have space limitations for **face-to-face** or **hosted** trainings, walk in registration may not be possible. Inevitably, the weather, family, or professional obligations make renewing your certificate problematic. Our best advice is, get your certification requirements done sooner rather than later. On April 1, 2025 your certifications will expire. Waiting until March 31st to act may not be a good strategy.

ATTENTION AERIAL APPLICATORS

North Dakota Administrative Code 60-03-01-5.1(4) requires that all aerial applicators seeking recertification must show proof of attendance at a Professional Aerial Applicators Support System (PAASS) program at least one time every three years before recertification may be issued.

This means that if you have not attended the PAASS program at the Tri-State Aerial Applicators Convention in 2023 OR 2024, you must attend the PAASS program this training season (2025).

Please note that the Safety Briefing sponsored by the North Dakota Aeronautics Commission is **not** a substitute for the PAASS program.

Applicant Acknowledgment of Proof of Financial Responsibility

NDCC 4.1-33-10 requires an applicant for a **commercial applicator certificate**, in the State of North Dakota, to provide proof of financial responsibility. NDCC 4.1-33-10 further requires that a commercial applicator must maintain financial responsibility in the amount of at least one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

Financial responsibility may be demonstrated by a notarized letter from an officer of a financial institution or from a certified public accountant attesting to the existence of net assets equal to at least one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), a performance bond, or a general liability insurance policy.

- I, the undersigned applicant, in lieu of providing proof of the above, attest and certify:
- (1) That I maintain financial responsibility in an amount of at least one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00). More specifically, I possess net assets equal to at least one hundred thousand dollars, a performance bond, or a general liability insurance policy;
- (2) Agree, upon request by the North Dakota Agriculture Commissioner, to immediately provide further proof of compliance with NDCC 4.1-33-10 satisfactory to the Agriculture Commissioner; and,
- (3) Understand that civil and/or criminal sanctions may be imposed, if I fail to abide by the pesticide control laws and regulations of the State of North Dakota (NDCC 4.1-33-20).
